The Story Behind This Powerful Book

The vision for the publication of a new edition of the World War II era devotional *Strength for Service to God and Country* began as the Eagle Scout project of a young boy in Southern California.



Evan Hunsberger found his grandfather’s battered copy of the book, which was originally published in 1942 and contained daily devotionals prepared by many of the leading protestant pastors and theologians of the time. He decided to republish the devotional in honor of his grandfather who carried it throughout his service in World War II. Making only slight changes to the text, he solicited additional contributions from today’s religious leaders. After three years of hard work, the

book was published.
